Other electronic clocking systems must be pre-arranged as reading equipment is not available.
Call to make arrangements at least two weeks prior to shipping night

Race Secretary fee \$3.00 per loft

Loft coordinates must be provided shipping night

ENTRY: \$20.00 PER BOND (**MUST BE IN BLOCKS OF 5**) NO LIMIT
ONLY 1000 BONDS WILL BE AVAILABLE
